PAINTING WARRANTY AGREEMENT REST TECH PAINTING LLC

This **Painting Warranty Agreement** ("Agreement") is entered into between Rest Tech Painting LLC ("Contractor") and the customer ("Client") for the painting services performed. The purpose of this Agreement is to outline the terms and conditions of the Contractor's warranty program.

1. WARRANTY COVERAGE

1.1 Warranty Term: The Contractor warrants that all labor related to painting services shall be free from defects in workmanship for a period of seven (7) years from the date of completion ("Warranty Period").

1.2 Warranty Documentation: The Contractor will maintain records of the warranty for seven (7) years. The Client is also encouraged to retain a copy of this Agreement for reference.

1.3 Product Warranties: All manufacturer warranties for materials and products used will be extended to the Client upon full payment for services rendered.

1.4 Liability Limitation: The Contractor's liability for any warranty claim shall not exceed the total price paid for the painting services.

2. WARRANTY CLAIMS

2.1 Notification of Defects: The Client must notify the Contractor immediately upon discovery of any defects or performance issues within the Warranty Period.

2.2 Exclusions: This warranty does not cover defects, damages, or failures caused by:

- The underlying substrate or any pre-existing coating failure.
- Structural shifting or settling of the property.
- Negligence, misuse, or intentional damage by the Client or third parties.
- Natural disasters, extreme weather conditions, or other acts of God.
- Exposure to excessive moisture, mold, mildew, chemicals, or harsh environmental conditions.
- Normal wear and tear, including fading, minor scuffs, or chips.

2.3 Limitations:

- The Contractor is not responsible for drywall, carpentry, or other repair services beyond the paint coating.

- The Contractor does not guarantee exact color matching due to fading, sheen variations, or discontinued paint lines.

2.4 Paint Storage Responsibility: The Client is responsible for storing any leftover paint in a temperature-controlled environment with properly sealed containers.

2.5 Additional Charges: Any work exceeding the initial project scope provided by the warranty coverage shall be subject to additional charges, only upon prior written consent of the Client.

2.6 Warranty Voidance: Failure to comply with the terms, conditions, and payment obligations of this Agreement shall render all warranties null and void.

4. GENERAL TERMS

4.1 Governing Law: This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the state of Connecticut.

4.2 Entire Agreement: This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the Contractor and the Client and supersedes any prior agreements, whether written or oral.

4.3 Severability: If any provision of this Agreement is deemed invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
